frank tender and brutally funny dimitri verhulst's semi autobiographical story details the vibrantly entertaining journey of a boy growing up in a family of alcoholics in belgium sobriety and moderation are alien concepts to the men in dimmy's family useless in all other respects his three uncles have a rare talent for drinking a flair for violence and an unwavering commitment to the pub and his father pierre is no slouch either within hours of his son's birth pierre plucks him from the maternity ward props him on his bike and takes him on an introductory tour of the village bars his mother soon leaves them to it and as dimmy grows up amid the stench of stale beer he seems destined to follow the path

of his forebears and make a low life career in inebriation until he begins to piece together his own plan for the future bringing to life the shambolic upbringing that the guardian describes as the odd ugly excremental poetry of their grubby lives the misfortunates can be unexpectedly tender as well as uncomfortably funny this novel continually surprises and intrigues

a literary page turner about one man's macabre ambition to create life and secure immortality the village of wolfheim is a quiet little place until the geneticist dr victor hoppe returns after an absence of nearly twenty years the doctor brings with him his infant children three identical boys all sharing a disturbing disfigurement he keeps them hidden away until charlotte the woman who is hired to care for them begins to suspect that the triplets and the good doctor aren't quite what they seem as the villagers become increasingly suspicious the story of dr hoppe's past begins to unfold and the shocking secrets that he has been keeping are revealed a chilling story that explores the ethical limits of science and religion the angel maker is a haunting tale in the tradition of the strange case of dr jekyll and mr hyde and frankenstein brought to life by internationally bestselling author stefan brijs this eerie tale promises to get under readers skin

dsir cordier mild mannered former librarian put upon husband lover of boules is losing his mind or is he happily tucked away in the winterlight home for the elderly dsir is looking forward to a quiet retirement with the other forgetful residents safe in the knowledge that no one knows he's faking his memory loss and as if there weren't reasons enough to opt out of the modern world it would be worth it just to see rosa rozendaal again the love of dsir's youth the one who got away but dementia isn't all fun and games there's a former war criminal hiding out in the home once beautiful rosa might be too far gone to return dsir's ardour and our hero soon begins to suspect he might not be the only one in winterlight who's acting a part a tender love story of demented minds and honourable hearts and a razor sharp satire of the indignities of old age and the callousness of caregiving the latecomer excoriates our society and asks might we all be better off forgetting

a poetic fable for grown ups full of wisdom and beauty by two belgian masters of graphic storytelling out on the high seas lives a whale unlike any other who spends her days reading stories to all who will listen taken from the vast library hidden in her belly when the whale bumps into a sea postman's boat one fateful night it's the beginning of an extraordinary friendship but not every story can have a happy ending

celebrated harvard professor at the height of her career when she notices a forgetfulness creeping into her life as confusion starts to cloud her thinking and her memory begins to fail her she receives a devastating diagnosis early onset alzheimer s disease fiercely independent alice struggles to maintain her lifestyle and live in the moment even as her sense of self is being stripped away in turns heartbreaking inspiring and terrifying still alice captures in remarkable detail what it s like to literally lose your mind reminiscent of a beautiful mind ordinary people and the curious incident of the dog in the night time still alice packs a powerful emotional punch and marks the arrival of a strong new voice in fiction

a beautifully illustrated catalog documenting an exhibition that explores alexander calder s impact on contemporary art the show at the kunsthall rotterdam runs from november 21 2021 may 29 2022 includes works by calder olafur eliasson zilvinas kempinas simone leigh ernesto neto carston nicolai aki sasamoto roman signer monica sosnowska sarah sze and rirkrit tiravanija the exhibition was created in cooperation with the calder foundation calder now documents an exhibition at the kunsthall rotterdam which explores the enduring influence of the work of alexander calder 1898 1976 on contemporary art shown alongside pieces by calder himself are works by 10 contemporary artists including olafur eliasson simone leigh ernesto neto rirkrit tiravanija and sarah sze the text explores the way their work resonates with calder s main artistic interests such as the reflection of light and movement three noted art historians elaborate on themes such as the participatory and progressive nature of calder s art

bernhard weicht provides a multi layered analysis of how we understand and construct care in everyday life the meanings it has for ourselves our families our relationships identities and our sense of society and what is right and proper making an original contribution to the discussion of the nature of care ethics and its political potential

now in paperback silke scheuermann s portrayal of intimacy and estrangement between sisters as they navigate rivalries addiction and shared love interests a young woman who has been living abroad returns to her hometown of frankfurt am main in germany her sister ines a beautiful impetuous painter who still lives there soon appears and promptly asks for financial help but the returning sister knew this was coming it is how their relationship has always worked and this time she s determined that that will change but our plans don t always hold up to the surprises presented by life and when the sister finds herself about to drift into an affair with ines s lover the two women grow unexpectedly closer the hour between dog and wolf is a tale of disorientation in a modern fundamentally rootless society that has become increasingly erratic and self absorbed it is a powerful exploration of the difficulties of intimacy and addiction

john taylor gatto s radical treatise on public education a bestseller for 25 years continues to advocate for the unshackling of children and learning from formal schooling now in a changing world with an explosion of alternative routes to learning it s poised to continue to shake the world of institutional education for many more years

i played the scene back about ten times in my mind first from start to finish then from finish to start in

slow motion frame by frame i tried to stop the action at the moment when my wife looked from me to the alderman i corrected myself avoided looking at the alderman robert walter popular mayor of amsterdam suspects his wife is cheating on him then robert s elderly parents tell him that they re planning to end their lives his father hints that it will be sooner rather than later but he won t say when alarmed robert starts to doubt himself and everyone around him lost in increasingly panicked and paranoid trains of thought but is it paranoia or is he actually seeing things clearly for the very first time the ditch shows how quickly even the most stable lives can be sabotaged by secrecy and suspicion and humans masochistic urge to undermine ourselves herman koch is rapidly becoming one of my favourite writers his three novels taken together are like a killer ep where every track kicks ass stephen king chilling nasty smart shocking and unputdownable gillian flynn on the dinner the dinner is a riveting compelling and deliciously uncomfortable read both a punch to the guts and a tonic it clears the air a wonderful book christos tsiolkas blackly funny full of sharp edges and hot issues and compulsively readable verdict feast on this herald sun on the dinner the dinner is a masterful disturbing piece of theatre age smh

he had never married and had never been with one woman for long he had always remained a collector of first times edward landauer a brilliant microbiologist in his forties meets a beautiful young woman she is the love of his life and when the two marry in france edward is the happiest man in the world at first ruth walta appears to represent a victory over time but even she cannot stop him growing older after the birth of their long awaited son the happiness delicate like filigree turns into something new and edward no longer recognises his great romance nor the woman who induced it praise for tommy wieringa brilliantly written the last few pages are mesmerising the saturday age while the narrative focuses on the collapse of one man s world it still raises huge moral questions haunting the sunday times

winner of the 2022 nobel prize in literature happening recounts what it was like to be a young woman whose life changed and world ominously narrowed in 1963 with an unwanted pregnancy it feels urgently of the moment the new york times in 1963 annie ernaux 23 and unattached realizes she is pregnant shame arises in her like a plague understanding that her pregnancy will mark her and her family as social failures she knows she cannot keep that child this is the story written forty years later of a trauma ernaux never overcame in a france where abortion was illegal she attempted in vain to self administer the abortion with a knitting needle fearful and desperate she finally located an abortionist and ends up in a hospital emergency ward where she nearly dies in happening ernaux sifts through her memories and her journal entries dating from those days clearly clearly she gleans the meanings of her experience now an award winning film by audrey diwan winner of the golden lion at the venice international film festival official selection of the sundance film festival

in rituals amsterdam of the fifties sixties and seventies is viewed from the perspective of the capricious inni wintrop an unintentional suicide survivor the unexpected gift of life returned lends him the curiosity and impartiality to survey others lives and routines inni s opposite the one eyed downhill skier arnold taads measures his life by the clock while his disowned son philip follows japanese rituals which themselves seem to render his existence meaningless a novel for those who seek to unravel our mysterious apparently directionless lives

a historical novel based on a true but unexplored aspect of the first world war the selling of cocaine to both sides by the dutch woven around a story of personal betrayal and self deception on july 31 1917 robin ryder the twenty six year old englishman clambers from his trench on a flanders battlefield and charges fearlessly towards the german lines heavily wounded by a german grenade half his mutilated face will have to be hidden behind a mask lucien hirschland the traveling salesman of the flourishing dutch cocaine factory is supplying both sides with drugs to make their soldiers more reckless in the face of overwhelming danger closing deals with both the germans and the british he flaunts his newfound wealth at the war s end extraordinary circumstances find ryder living in the hirschland family home where he is lovingly welcomed by lucien s younger sister swanee expectations and illusions grow as their lives spin out of and they learn that the war veteran has more to hide than his mutilated face conny braam helped set up and then led the dutch anti apartheid movement her books include operatie vulva de bokkeslachter and zwavel a trilogy of novels about the family abraham

based on a woman who appeared briefly in casanova s legendary diaries here is an elegant and moving story of love denied and transformed from the author of the two hearts of kwasi boachi intelligent poignant and yes sexy a literary page turner for those with a brain as well as a heart san francisco chronicle lucia works as a servant girl in italy and is engaged to be married but after the pox disfigures her face she flees in shame without telling her lover years later as a reknowned amsterdam courtesan who never goes out without her veil lucia is at the theater when she recognizes her long lost fiancé giacomo casanova and she cannot resist the opportunity to encounter him again based on a woman who appeared briefly in casanova s legendary diaries lucia emerges as a brilliant woman who becomes every bit his match in lucia s eyes is an elegant and moving story of love denied and transformed

a sensuous textured novel of life in a refugee camp long listed for the orwell prize for political fiction on a hill overlooking a refugee camp in sudan a young man strings up bedsheets that in an act of imaginative resilience will serve as a screen in his silent cinema from the cinema he can see all the comings and goings in the camp especially those of two new arrivals a girl named saba and her mute brother hagos for these siblings adapting to life in the camp is not easy saba mourns the future she lost when she was forced to abandon school while hagos scorned for his inability to speak must live vicariously through his sister both resist societal expectations by seeking to redefine love sex and

gender roles in their lives and when a businessman opens a shop and befriends hagos they cast off those pressures and make an unconventional choice with this cast of complex beautifully drawn characters sulaiman addonia details the textures and rhythms of everyday life in a refugee camp and questions what it means to be an individual when one has lost all that makes a home or a future intimate and subversive silence is my mother tongue dissects the ways society wages war on women and explores the stories we must tell to survive in a broken inhospitable environment

on a small island in a glacier fed lake on alaska s kenai peninsula a marriage is unravelling gary driven by thirty years of diverted plans and irene haunted by a tragedy in her past are trying to rebuild their life together following the outline of gary s old dream they re hauling logs out to caribou island in good weather and in terrible storms in sickness and in health to patch together the kind of cabin that drew them to alaska in the first place across the water on the mainland irene and gary s grown daughter rhoda is starting her own life she fantasizes about the perfect wedding day whilst her betrothed jim the dentist wonders about the possibility of an altogether different future from the author of the massively acclaimed legend of a suicide comes a devastating novel about a marriage a couple blighted by past shadows and the weight of expectation of themselves and of each other brilliantly drawn and fiercely honest in its depiction of love and disappointment david vann s first novel confirms him as one of america s most dazzling writers of fiction

follows the experiences of giovanni talamini a poet who is torn between his family's and his own needs when he returns to italy to help run the ice cream dynasty he left behind years earlier

fifty years after its first publication discover the classic coming of age novel that confronts prejudice and injustice with power and humanity with an introduction by rita mae brown molly bolt is a young lady with a big character beautiful funny and bright molly figures out at a young age that she will have to be tough to stay true to herself in 1950s america in her dealings with boyfriends and girlfriends in the rocky relationship with her mother and in her determination to pursue her career she will fight for her right to happiness charming proud and inspiring molly is the girl who refuses to be put in a box

paris today the museum of broken promises is a place of hope and loss every object in the museum has been donated a cake tin a wedding veil a baby's shoe and each represents a moment of grief or terrible betrayal laurie the owner and curator has also hidden artefacts from her own painful youth amongst the objects on display 1985 recovering from the sudden death of her father laurie flees to prague but she cannot begin to comprehend the dark political currents in this communist city until she meets a young dissident musician her love for him however will have terrible and unforeseen consequences it is only years later having created the museum that laurie can finally face up to her past and celebrate the passionate love which has directed her life

while hiding from the limelight banksy has made himself into one of the world's best known living artists his pieces have fetched millions of dollars at prestigious auction houses he was nominated for an academy award for his film exit through the gift shop once viewed as vandalism his work is now venerated fans have gone so far as to dismantle the walls that he has painted on for collection and sale but as famous as banksy is he is also utterly unknown he conceals his real name hides his face distorts his voice and reveals his identity to only a select few who is this man that has captivated millions how did a graffiti artist from bristol england find himself at the center of an artistic movement how has someone who goes to such great lengths to keep himself hidden achieved such great notoriety and is his anonymity a necessity to continue his vandalism or a marketing tool to make him ever more famous now in the first ever full scale investigation of the artist reporter will ellsworth jones pieces together the story of banksy building up a picture of the man and the world in

which he operates he talks to his friends and enemies those who knew him in his early unnoticed days and those who have watched him try to come to terms with his newfound fame and success and he explores the contradictions of a champion of renegade art going to greater and greater lengths to control his image and his work banksy offers a revealing glimpse at an enigmatic figure and a riveting account of how a self professed vandal became an international icon and turned the art world upside down in the process

a young dutch geologist alfred issendorf is determined to win fame for making a great discovery to this end he joins a small geological expedition to the far north of norway where he hopes to be the first to identify craters made by meteorites in the landscape it is a harsh and deserted environment way beyond civilisation which brings out all the faultlines in the group of young men and in alfred s character the tribulations mount alfred is unable to procure crucial aerial photographs he falls on rocks is soaked in a river and is beset by mosquitoes and insomnia the tent leaks appallingly he is not a natural athlete feeling incapable and superfluous to the group s needs alfred becomes desperate and paranoid suspecting the others are leagued in conspiracy against him haunted by the ghost of his scientist father unable to escape the looming influence of his mother and anxious to complete the thesis that will make his name alfred s preoccupations multiply in this wilderness as piece by piece his equipment is lost or ruined and his thinking becomes ever more disjointed he moves towards the final act of vanity which will trigger a catastrophe sleep no

a furiously paced psychological thriller about a woman accused of attempting to murder her son perfect for fans of paula hawkins shortly after a fractious weekend away with her family gaelle wakes up injured in a psychiatric hospital in berlin her seven year old son is in a coma in another hospital and the police suspect her of attempting to murder him with no memory of what happened but convinced of her innocence gaelle escapes and begins a determined hunt for the truth michael is a contract killer working for scorpio a ruthless organization that spares no one where any agent who violates the rules signs their own death warrant when michael decides to reject an assignment he knows he must run for his life one makes a living by killing the other would kill to survive and soon their paths will cross an exhilarating addition to the walter presents library
