shining a light on the deadly health consequences of incarceration finalist in the prose award for best book in anthropology criminology and sociology by the association of american publishers kalief browder was 16 when he was arrested in the bronx for allegedly stealing a backpack unable to raise bail and unwilling to plead guilty to a crime he didn t commit browder spent three years in new york s infamous rikers island jail two in solitary confinement while awaiting trial after his case was dismissed in 2013 browder returned to his family haunted by his ordeal suffering through the lonely hell of solitary browder had been violently attacked by fellow prisoners and corrections officers throughout his incarceration consumed with depression browder committed suicide in 2015 he was just 22 years old in life and death in rikers island homer venters the former chief medical officer for new york city s jails explains the profound health risks associated with incarceration from neglect and sexual abuse to blocked access to care and exposure to brutality venters details how jails are designed and run to create new health risks for prisoners all while forcing doctors and nurses into complicity or silence pairing prisoner experiences with cutting edge research into prison risk venters reveals the disproportionate extent to which the health risks of jail are meted out to those with behavioral health problems and people of color he also presents compelling data on alternative strategies that can reduce health risks this revelatory and groundbreaking book concludes with the author s analysis of the case for closing rikers island jails and his advice on how to do it for the good of the incarcerated

kurt vonnegut s masterpiece slaughterhouse five is a desperate painfully honest attempt to confront the monstrous crimes of the twentieth century time selected by the modern library as one of the 100 best novels of all time one of the atlantic s great american novels of the past 100 years slaughterhouse five an american classic is one of the world s great antiwar books centering on the infamous world war ii firebombing of dresden the novel is the result of what kurt vonnegut described as a twenty three year struggle to write a book about what he had witnessed as an american prisoner of war it combines historical fiction science fiction autobiography and satire in an account of the life of billy pilgrim a barber s son turned draftee turned optometrist turned alien abductee as vonnegut had billy experiences the destruction of dresden as a pow unlike vonnegut he experiences time travel or coming unstuck in time an instant bestseller slaughterhouse five made kurt vonnegut a cult hero in american literature a reputation that only strengthened over time despite his being banned and censored by some libraries and schools for content and language but it was precisely those elements of vonnegut s writing the political edginess the genre bending inventiveness the frank violence the transgressive wit that have inspired generations of readers not just to look differently at the world around them but to find the confidence to say something about it authors as wide ranging as norman mailer john irving michael crichton tim o brien margaret atwood elizabeth strout david sedaris jennifer egan and j k rowling have all found inspiration in vonnegut s

words jonathan safran foer has described vonnegut as the kind of writer who made people young people especially want to write george saunders has declared vonnegut to be the great urgent passionate american writer of our century who offers us a model of the kind of compassionate thinking that might yet save us from ourselves more than fifty years after its initial publication at the height of the vietnam war vonnegut s portrayal of political disillusionment ptsd and postwar anxiety feels as relevant darkly humorous and profoundly affecting as ever an enduring beacon through our own era s uncertainties
